### **Real English: Blast from the Past** 过去回忆的唤醒

Helen: Hello, this is Real English from BBC Learning English, I'm Helen.

Jean: 大家好，我是董征。欢迎收听地道英语。

Helen: In Real English, we look at words and phrases that you might not find in your dictionary.

Jean: 和汉语一样，英语语言里也是有好多的成语和俗语的。所以要想听得懂英国人日常的说话聊天，咱们就要多学点儿这些通俗语言和用法。

Helen: And today's expression is used to talk about memories...
